# Grant Application

In CALIPSOplus authors, receiving Transnational Access funding by CALIPSOplus, can apply for a grant (max. EUR 1 500) to cover the open-access publishing fees in order to cure this problem and at the same time encourage users to open access publishing. Funding will be given – upon application to the coordinator – with priority to users from countries/institutions with very small research budgets but wishing to publish excellent research in "gold" open access journals.

# **Grant application**

The applicant should send the application via email to the CALIPSOplus Management (email below) including the following information:

- Abstract of project
- Journal
- Draft of publication or accepted paper
- Facility, beamline and date of beamtime where/when experiments of publication has been measured

# Open Access to scientific publications

**Open access (OA)** refers to the practice of providing online access to scientific information that is free of charge to the end-user and reusable. 'Scientific' refers to all academic disciplines.

Why open access to scientific peer-reviewed publications?

#### **Good for science**

- Allows scientists to build on previous research results and avoid unnecessary duplication of effort
- Improved quality and greater efficiency

## **Good for economy**

- Speeds up innovations
- Faster progress to market

# **Good for society**

- Makes research available to individual citizens and non-profit organizations
- Greater transparency

# How to achieve open access in Horizon 2020

Open Access publication in Horizon 2020 is possible by means of so-called "Gold Open Access" and "Green Open Access" publication, respectively.

# Gold Open Access

Articles published in open access mode (publishing costs borne by the authors, universities or institutes etc.)

e.g. New J. Phys., Optics Express, Nature Comm. Peer-reviewed, purely electronic journals

## Green Open Access

Published articles or the final peer-reviewed manuscript are deposited in an online repository.

e.g. ArXiv.org

Both options of open access publication are possible. **To emphasize the possibility of Gold Open Access publication** for results obtained in experiments funded by CALIPSOplus the project awards grants for Gold Open Access publication.
